We had to cancel the Shamrock Wreck due to the Hurricane and re-scheduled the Grande Fall Petite Cheminot very quickly with the help of host Voiture Locale 499 in Loganville. There were many issues discussed at the Cheminot that will be decided at the Mid-Winter Cheminot in February including the Grande Raffle drawing where three lucky people will win \$500, \$300 and \$200. We will also take bids for the Grande Promenade and discuss resolutions for next years candidates for Grande Officers among other things. So as you can see this is a very important Grande Cheminot with a full schedule and will need the support from all Voyageurs. It will be held on Saturday, February 18, 2017 at Voiture Locale 217, Fulton Co. at 1:00 pm.



3 Levels of Program Responsibility in La Societe

There seems to be confusion on who is responsible for what programs of La Societe and I would like to pass on what was taught to me by those that preceded me, on how to work the programs successfully.

Obviously there are three levels of responsibility in our programs and this is all programs including membership. Those three levels are Nationale, Grande and Locale with all being of equal importance. However if any level fails to meet their responsibility, then the chain of success is broken and your chances for a good year are severely hampered.

The Nationale level is comprised of the Nationale Directeurs, Sous Directeurs, Sous Chefs de Chemin de Fer and the Chef de Chemin de Fer. Voiture Nationale provides these officers with information and stats on their programs and in turn it is their duty to pass them on to their program committee members and to the assigned Grandes in each Region. This is the beginning of the process. These officers are also responsible for dispersing any information that they think may be of value to the Grandes and to motivate their Grande Officers every so often to keep the Grandes interested in their programs. This is also a level that would offer advice to and answer questions for any Grande Officer that would need it. The main three contact officers in the Grande for all Nationale program officers are the Grande Directeur of their respective program, the Grande Correspondant and the Grande Chef de Gare. You may find that a Nationale Directeur may ask for other contacts but these would be the minimum at least once a month. Basically the Nationale level of program responsibility are the Grandes.

The next level of responsibility is the Grande level, their duty is to pass on the info and stats they receive from the Nationale Officers to their respective Locales. Never believe there is too much communication because that is untrue and between the Grande Directeur, Correspondant and Chef, the communication chain should reach every Locale in the Grandes. At the very least the Grande Correspondant should disperse the information because by their title, Correspondant, that's the very nature of their job, to correspond. Each Grande should have a program Directeur for each program and if this is not possible then assign someone to oversee each program at the Grande level. The Grande should always be available to answer questions and solve problems for their Locales. It goes without saying that Grande Officers should keep the Locale Officers motivated, advise and furnish them with any material that would benefit their program. They should also pay special attention to problem Locales to get their programs moving to be successful. So as you can see, the Grande level is responsible for their Locales

That brings us to the Locales or as I call them, the foundation of La Societe. This is where it all starts and where success or failure for any program is created. It is the duty of each Locale Officer to make sure that the correspondence from their Grande is dispersed to the Locale Officers and Voyageurs. Never believe that any program is not important and does not need to be supported. After all, each Voyageur took an oath to "support the programs of La Societe." Never think that the Locale level is not important because that is the backbone of the organization. If they fail then the Nationale Programs fail as well. So the responsibility of the Locale level is to communicate to the individual members, this is how all Voyageurs are kept up to date and informed of the Program progress, any new additions or changes to the program and how to get donations, pins or involved. So the Blue Chapeaus are the key to any year's success or failure. So a big responsibility rests on the Locale as the contact point for the membership.

Remember these three levels and keep your responsibility at whatever level you are involved in. Don't worry about the other levels because if everyone does what is required of them, they will take care of themselves. It is a simple three level system of success, but if one level fails to do their job, it breaks down the levels just like a three level building. "Some will do their job and some will not, but in the end we will all be judged by the same thing, success or failure." Let's all commit ourselves to live up to our oaths and support our programs on one of the three levels we serve.
